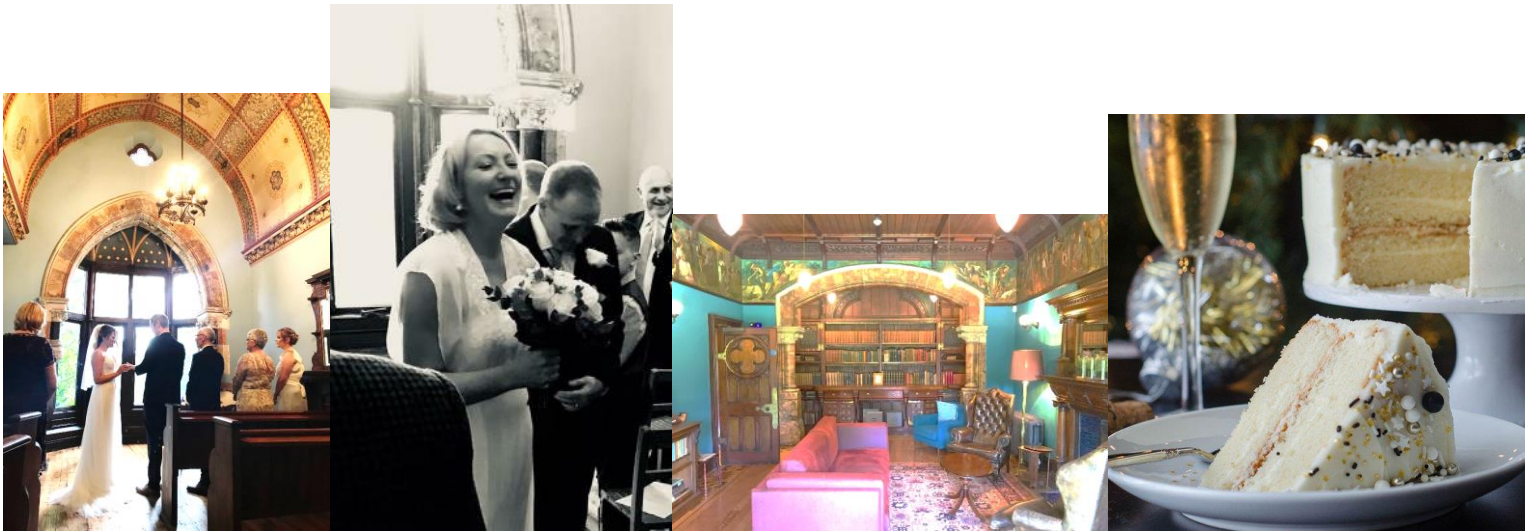

The legal bit

- Unfortunately, we can't get involved with the legal arrangements and you need to contact Cardiff Registry Office yourselves to book your Registrar for the ceremony
- Notice of marriage must be given 29 days before a ceremony is held, therefore your booking with Cardiff Registry Office must be in place 29 days in advance
- Registrar fees apply

Guest numbers

- Each of our licenced spaces has a specific number of 'Socially Distanced Points'
- Between each point there is a 2m+ gap
- Each point could be one guest or 2 guests who live in the same household
- The 2 Registrars occupy a point, each
- You, the couple will occupy one point
- A photographer/videographer would also occupy one of these points
- Children aged 11 or under don't have to socially distance so don't count in the numbers
- We have wifi on the entire site and can help you to 'Zoom' in any of your guests who can't be in the room at the time

The Celebration

- Relax in one of hire spaces for a 2-hour celebration with your guests following the ceremony
- Currently a maximum of 15 adults can attend a wedding reception indoors. If your numbers exceed this, take your reception outdoors where you can enjoy our grounds with up to 30 adults
- Indoor receptions must be seated, and masks worn at all times, apart from when eating and drinking
- No loud music can be played (to avoid guests having to raise their voices)
- Dancing is only permitted by the couple, to ensure social distancing is maintained
- A cake (Victoria sponge, chocolate, or carrot), cake stand, cake knife and napkins will be made available to you
- We will provide you with enough sparkling wine for one glass for each of your guests
- Our grounds are open to the public, daily, and you are welcome to enjoy these outside areas for photos following your ceremony
- Access to our tower for photographs is strictly limited to you, the couple (if you live in the same household), and a single photographer

Safety

- Your guests will be greeted on arrival and asked to wait in a waiting room
- Your guests will then be invited one by one, or in pairs to their allocated seats
- Hand sanitiser will be available for guests to use
- The rooms used will be thoroughly cleaned ahead of use as well as after
- Face masks must be worn by all guests (aged 12 and over), unless exempt. The couple doesn't have to wear a face covering for the ceremony itself, but must at all other times when indoors
- Unfortunately, no live readings can be given during the ceremony itself, but pre-recorded readings can be played
